1 Memorial to Ishikawa Takuboku Monument and Gallery

The monument was erected next to the site where famous poet Ishikawa Takuboku spent the final few months of his life. It was built using stone from Himekamisan, Iwate Prefecture, Takuboku's hometown, and a handwritten manuscript of his final two poems was reproduced on a porcelain panel. The gallery next to the monument contains an exhibition of manuscript replica, photographs, and panels depicting the life of the poet.

Koishikawa Area

Koishikawa Annex, The University Museum, The University of Tokyo

Botanical Gardens, Graduate School of Science, The University of Tokyo

The Museum of Architecture within the oldest school building of the University of Tokyo.

Hakusan/Honkomagome Area

Inoue Enryo Memorial Museum, Toyo University
Toyo University's historical materials and art objects are on display.

Toyo Bunko Museum
This museum features a complete set of books that enable visitors to get a good understanding of Asian history and culture.

Rikugien Gardens
Enjoy seasonal flowers such as cherry blossoms, azaleas, and autumn leaves as well as the change of the landscape throughout the year.

Nezu/Sendagi Area

Nippon Medical School Saisei Gakusha Gallery
Take a look at the monument of the former residence of Soeiki Natsume with a title written by Yasunari Kawabata, which is located on the premises.

Insect Museum of J.H.Fabre
You can see insects super magnified with a unique tool "Mushi Mega Ne-Kun".

Mori Ogai Memorial Museum
Trace the history of Mori Ogai's life at the permanent exhibition, and learn about all the things Ogai did through special exhibitions held four times a year!

Sentaro Iwata Collection Kindonichikan Museum
This museum preserves almost 800 works of Sentaro, the last successor of Edo Ukiyo-e Bijin-ga.

Takehisa Yumeji Museum
This museum has a collection of 3,300 works by Yumeji Takehisa, with themed exhibitions held four times a year.

Yayoi Museum
This museum exhibits the artworks of Kashi Takabatake who succeeded as an illustrator in the early Showa period. In addition, the unique temporary exhibitions are very popular.

The Former Kusuo Yasuda Residence and Gardens
You can enjoy Japanese gardens and over one-hundred-year-old Japanese architecture.

There are information boards with history and highlights in various places.


